THE PERSON & WORK OF CHRIST, PT. 3; COL. 1:17a-b (Ed O'Leary)

INTRODUCTION.

WE ARE CONTINUING TO MAKE OUR WAY THROUGH COL. ~ 1: ~ 15-20, ~ Paul's discussion ~ about the Person and work of Jesus.

▶►As we are well aware by now, ~ Col. ~ 1: ~ 15-20 ~ is one of the most, ~ if not the most, ~~ conclusive passages on the Person and work of Jesus in all of Scripture.

RECALL PAUL'S PURPOSE FOR ADDING THIS DISCUSSION.

- ▶ False teachers in Colossae ~ were assaulting and misrepresenting ~ the Person and work of Christ.
- $\blacktriangleright \blacktriangleright$ So, \sim in order to counter this attack and falsification of Jesus' Person and work, ~ 77

Paul lays out 10 sweeping and profound assertions which set the record straight.

OF COURSE, ~ FALSE TEACHERS WERE NOT RESTRICTED TO THE FIRST CENTURY.

▶▶They have plagued the church throughout her history. ~~ And it's no different today.

 \triangleright In his second epistle, ~ Peter writes, ~ 77

 \rightarrow But false prophets also arose among the people, \sim just as there will be false teachers among you. $\Rightarrow \Rightarrow 1^{st}$ century. \sim But applies to every gen. of believers.

▶►And false teachers ~ are still attacking and distorting the biblical teaching about the Person and work of Jesus.

SO FAR, ~ WE HAVE LOOKED AT THE FIRST 3 ASSERTIONS ABOUT JESUS. 11 1/13

▶▶Jesus is the visible expression of the invisible God. ~~ He is supreme over all creation. ~~ And he is the sovereign Creator of the universe. TODAY, ~ WE'LL CONSIDER THE FOURTH AND FIFTH ASSERTIONS. THE FOURTH ASSERTION. ~~ VERSE 17a. HE IS BEFORE ALL THINGS. ▶▶I.e., ~ as we'll see as we unpack this, ~ Jesus is eternal. "BEFORE" REFERS TO JESUS' PREEXISTENCE. ~~ I.E., ~ JESUS PREEXISTED ALL THINGS. ▶▶But not in the sense of being created first, ~ as the heretics were teaching. \triangleright And in our day, ~ cults like the JW's teach. ▶ Notice how Paul words this. ~~ he ~ is ~ before all things. >>Not, ~ "he ~ was ~ before all things." ▶▶The form of the Greek verb for ~ "is" ~ indicates ~ eternal existence, ~ an attribute of deity. ▶▶Mere preexistence, ~ i.e., ~ created before everything else, ~ could have been set forth with the verb ~ "was." >> However, ~ the text states that ~ Jesus is before all things, ~ not that He was before all things.

 \triangleright This verb structure can refer ~ only ~ to God. 11 2/13

▶▶Jesus is eternal, ~ and therefore God, ~ since only God is eternal.

JN. ~ 8: ~ 56-58, ~ SHOWS US THAT JESUS HIMSELF ~ WAS ALSO QUITE CLEAR ON this matter.

▶▶Speaking to the Jews, ~ He said, ~ 77

 DD^{56} Your father Abraham rejoiced that he would see my day. ~~ He saw it and was glad." ~~ 57 So the Jews said to him, ~ "You are not yet fifty years old, ~ and have you seen Abraham?" ~~ 77

→ → 58 Jesus said to them, ~ "Truly, ~ I say to you, ~ before Abraham was, ~ I am ~ [notice: ~~ not I was]."

- ▶▶Phrase, ~ "I am" ~ implies continuous existence, ~ including existence when Abraham lived.
- ▶▶By using the timeless ~ "I am" ~ rather than ~ "I was," ~ 77

DDJesus conveyed not only the idea of existence ~ prior to Abraham, ~ 77

→ but timelessness, ~ eternality, ~ the very nature of God Himself.

▶▶And the Jews did not miss his claim of being God.

 \triangleright Verse 59, \sim So they picked up stones to throw at him, \sim but Jesus hid himself and went out of the temple.

 \triangleright \triangleright They knew exactly who he was claiming to be: ~~ Yahweh.

▶▶Moses and the burning bush. 11 3/13

▶ Pick it up with Ex. ~ 3: ~ 13-14.

 \triangleright \triangleright ¹³ Then Moses said to God, ~~ "If I come to the people of Israel and say to them, ~ 'The God of your fathers has sent me to you,' ~~ and they ask me, ~ 'What is his name?' ~~ what shall I say to them?" ~~ ¹⁴ God said to Moses, ~~ "I am who I am." ~~ And he said, ~ "Say this to the people of Israel: ~~ 'I am has sent me to you."

▶► Certainly the Jews did not miss the reference to this incident ~ 77

Dand the clear claim by Jesus that he is the One who spoke to Moses from the burning bush.

 \rightarrow They picked up stones to throw at him. ~~ Accused of blasphemy. ~~ Stoning was the punishment for this sin.

▶▶Jesus may also have been alluding to Is. ~ 45: ~ 18 ~ LEB.

 \triangleright For thus says Yahweh, ~ who created the heavens, ~ he is God, ~ who formed the earth and who made it. ~~ He himself established it; ~~ he did not create it as emptiness — he formed it for inhabiting. ~~ "I am Yahweh ~ and there is none besides me."

THE APOSTLE JOHN WAS QUITE CLEAR ON THIS AS WELL.

- ▶▶John begins his gospel with, ~ "In the beginning was the Word."
- ▶▶Phrase, ~ "In the beginning" ~ means in effect ~ "before creation began."

>> "Before the universe was created, ~ the Word was."

- →→ The Word is said to already exist before creation began.
- ▶▶John does not say, ~ "Before the universe was created, ~ the Word began."

 \triangleright IOW, ~ John is not saying that Jesus was the first-created, ~ 77

 \rightarrow and then the rest of the universe was created, \sim like the heretics claimed, \sim and JW's today claim. 11 4/13

- ▶▶But rather, ~ John declares, ~ "Before the universe was created, ~ the Word was."
- ▶▶The verb form for "was" signifies ~ timeless existence.
 - \triangleright We could express the idea this way: ~~ 77
 - ⇒⇒"Before the universe was created, ~ the Word was already eternally existing."
- ▶▶We know from John's gospel that ~ "the Word" ~ is Jesus.
- ▶ John is saying ~ that before the universe was created, ~ Jesus was already eternally existing.
 - >>No matter how far back one goes, ~ Jesus was continuously existing.
 - \triangleright Jesus had no origin, \sim no beginning. \sim His humanity had a beginning, \sim but not his divine Person.

AND THE AUTHOR OF HEBREWS WAS EQUALLY CLEAR.

- ▶▶In verse 8a of chapter 1, ~ the writer of Hebrews begins a series of OT quotations.
- ▶▶The preface to those statements is, ~ "But of the Son he says."
- $\blacktriangleright \blacktriangleright$ Consequently, \sim the statements to follow refer to Jesus.
- Therefore, ~ the statement in vs. 8b, ~ Your throne, O God, ~ is forever and ever," ~ 77 D is a reference to the eternality of Christ.

▶▶In predicting that the Messiah, ~ who is Jesus, ~ would be born in Bethlehem, ~ 77

>> Micah said that the Messiah's "goings forth are from long ago, ~ from the days of eternity."

 $\triangleright \triangleright$ Although Jesus was born in Bethlehem, ~~ that was not His beginning. ~~ He has existed "from the days of eternity.

THERE IS INDIRECT SCRIPTURAL PROOF FOR JESUS' ETERNALITY AS WELL.

AT LEAST FOUR TIMES IN JOHN'S GOSPEL THERE IS A REFERENCE TO JESUS' HAVING "descended from heaven."

- ▶▶If Jesus came down from heaven, ~ then Bethlehem cannot have been his beginning.
- ▶ These verses indicate he dwelt in heaven before coming to earth, ~ pointing to his eternality.

REFERRING TO JESUS, ~ JOHN WRITES, ~ 77

- ▶▶"Isaiah said these things because he saw his glory and spoke of him." (Jn. 12)
- ▶▶In the context of John, ~ this is a reference to Jesus.
- ▶▶However, ~ John was quoting from Is. ~ 6: ~ 10, ~ where Isaiah was clearly referring to Yahweh.
- ▶▶Recall that Is. 6 records Isaiah's vision of Yahweh. ~~ Remember how that begins.
 - \triangleright In the year that King Uzziah died ~ I saw the Lord sitting upon a throne, ~ high and lifted up; ~~ and the train of his robe filled the temple. 11 6/13

- ▶▶John, ~ in his gospel, ~ thus equates Jesus with Yahweh.
 - >>Because Yahweh is eternal ~ then Jesus, ~ being Yahweh, ~ is eternal.

IN MATTHEW'S GOSPEL, ~ YOU CAN READ IT IN MATT. 22, ~ JESUS QUOTES PS. 110:1.

- ► The Lord said to my Lord, ~ "Sit at my right hand, ~ until I put your enemies under your feet."
- ►►And he applies it to himself.
- ▶▶The term "Lord" ~ is Adonai, ~ one of the Old Testament names of God.
- ▶▶If Christ is designated Adonai, ~ and he is, ~ then He is eternal, ~ for God is eternal.

BOTH DIRECT AND INDIRECT PROOF.

▶▶The scriptural evidence for Jesus' eternality is extensive.

OK, LET'S CATCH OUR BREATH.

FALSE TEACHERS IN COLOSSAE ~ WERE ASSAULTING AND MISREPRESENTING ~ THE Person and work of Christ.

- ▶▶So, ~ in order to counter this attack and falsification of Jesus' Person and work, ~ 77
 - DPaul lays out 10 sweeping and profound assertions which set the record straight.
 - \rightarrow And we have just finished the 4th statement: ~~ Jesus is eternal.

VERSE 17b. ~~ BY HIM ~ [I.E., ~ IN JESUS] ~ ALL THINGS HOLD TOGETHER.

- ► Could be paraphrased as, ~ "Jesus holds all creation together."
- ▶▶Not only is Jesus the Creator of all things, ~ all things continue to exist because of him.
- ► Furthermore, ~ "hold together" ~ implies ~ 77
 - Deling held together in a coherent or logical way, ~ sustained and upheld, ~ 77
 - → under control, ~ prevented from dissolving into disorder and confusion.
- ▶▶Jesus keeps the cosmos ~ from becoming a chaos.
- ▶▶Without him, ~ electrons would not continue to circle nuclei, ~ 77
 - Degravity would cease to work, ~ the planets would not stay in their orbits.
- ▶ Jesus is the one ~ who makes the sun shine.
 - >>He is the one ~ who causes the earth to rotate on its axis and orbit the sun.
 - $\triangleright \triangleright$ Jesus is the one \sim who continues to grant life to our bodies.
 - → → As Paul told the Athenians ~ Acts 17, ~ in God "we live and move and exist."
 - → Our very creation and continued existence depends on Jesus. 11 8/13

HEBREWS 1:3b IS A PARALLEL VERSE TO COL. 1:17b, ~ AND TELLS US HOW JESUS holds all things together. ▶ he ~ i.e., ~ Jesus, ~ upholds the universe by the word of his power. ▶▶By His mighty word He called the universe into existence. >> And he upholds the universe by the power of his word. ▶▶It is ~ Jesus' powerful word ~ that keeps the earth spinning on its axis. >>It is his almighty word ~ that keeps it revolving around the sun. >>It is by his powerful word ~ that "we live and move and exist." FROM WHAT HAS BEEN SAID, ~ HERE ARE TWO SIMPLE IMPLICATIONS FOR OUR lives. $\triangleright \triangleright 1^{st}$, ~ we ought to be extremely grateful to our Savior. \triangleright Every day we live, ~ every breath we take, ~ every rotation of the earth, ~ 77 → every trip around the sun, ~ is a gift from our loving, ~ gracious, ~ and merciful Lord. $\triangleright 2^{nd}$, ~ when we consider our Savior's awesome power, ~ 77

 \triangleright And he holds it together and causes it to run smoothly. 11 9/13

>>He spoke the universe into existence.

Dit should boost ~ our trust in him ~ and our confidence in his promises.

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\triangleright \triangleright Surely he has the power to meet our needs, ~ 77
        → to see us through all the storms, ~ trials, ~ and tragedies of life, ~ 77
           → and to bring us safely into his heavenly kingdom.
    >>Immediately following Jesus' ascension, ~ 77
        → two angels appeared and told the disciples that Jesus would return.
           → Surely no earthly or demonic power can prevent this from happening.
JESUS HOLDS ALL CREATION TOGETHER BY THE POWER OF HIS MIGHTY WORD.
 ▶▶I read of a group of people who toured an atomic laboratory.
    >> The guide explained how all matter was composed of rapidly moving electric particles.
    >> The group studied models of molecules ~ and were amazed to learn that matter is
    made up primarily of space.
    >> During the question period, ~ one of the group asked, ~ 77
        →→"If this is the way matter works, ~ what holds it all together?"
           →→For that, ~ the guide had no answer.
 ▶ Everyone one of us in this room knows how gravity works.
    >>However, ~ according to Prof. John Lennox, ~ Newton's law of gravitation doesn't tell
    us what gravity is.
    \triangleright \trianglerightNo one knows what it is. 11 10/13
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▶▶What's more, ~ it's a puzzle why the nucleus of an atom holds together. >> According to Coulomb's law of electrostatic force and the law of magnetism, ~ atoms shouldn't hold together. → They should fly apart. ~~ But they don't. >>Experiments performed in the 1920s and 1930s ~ 77 → gave scientists an understanding ~ 77 → of the incredibly powerful force that holds protons together within the nucleus of an atom. >>Scientists have dubbed that force ~ the "strong nuclear force," ~ 77 → but have no explanation ~ for why it exists. ▶▶Well, ~ Paul and the author of Hebrews ~ give us the explanation ~ and the answer to that person's question: ~~ Jesus. THAT JESUS NOT ONLY CREATED THE UNIVERSE ~ BUT ALSO UPHOLDS IT, ~ SHOWS us that Jesus is very much active in the universe. ▶▶He did not simply ~ start things off ~ and then withdrew from his creation, ~ like Deism teaches. Deism is essentially the view that God exists, ~ but that He is not directly involved in the world. >> Deism pictures God ~ as the great "clockmaker" ~ who created the clock, ~ wound it up, ~ and let it go. ▶▶Jesus ~ continues to sustain ~ and is very much active in ~ the universe. 11/13

JESUS IS ALSO VERY ACTIVE IN THE LIVES OF HIS PEOPLE.

- ▶ We see his activity in the lives of his people from what God says through Isaiah (41).
- ▶▶Yahweh tells us to fear not and to not be dismayed.
 - >> Why? ~~ Because he tells us that he is with us and that he is our God.
- ▶▶Then the Lord tells us what he means by that.
 - \triangleright He promises to be with us, ~ to help us, ~ 77
 - → and to hold on to us by his righteous right hand.

FURTHERMORE, ~ JESUS IS VERY ACTIVE IN HUMAN HISTORY.

- ▶ Everything that takes place is subject to His sovereignty and authority.
- ▶▶In fact, ~ He orchestrates everything to bring about the Father's divine sovereign plan.
 - $\triangleright \triangleright$ And that is, ~ as Paul points out in Eph., ~ 77
 - → → to unite all things in [Jesus], ~ things in heaven and things on earth.
- $\blacktriangleright \blacktriangleright G$ od the Father planned before He created the universe, ~ 77
 - $\triangleright \triangleright$ to bring all things together under the authority and leadership of Jesus.
- ▶▶This plan is being worked out daily
- $\blacktriangleright \blacktriangleright$ And we can rest assured that this plan will be brought to completion, ~ 77
 - → because God's plans cannot be thwarted ~ and are always fulfilled. 11 12/13

- $\rightarrow \rightarrow As$ Isaiah says, ~ "For the Lord of hosts has purposed, ~ and who will annul it? ~~ His hand is stretched out, ~ and who will turn it back?"
- ▶▶Human history is not random ~ and is being guided to its divinely-appointed end, ~ 77
 - Dwhich will culminate in the return of Christ and new heavens and a new earth.
- ▶▶And no matter how chaotic and out of control things seem to be, ~ 77
 - $\triangleright \triangleright$ no matter how much it appears that evil is winning, \sim the Father's plan will be brought to completion.
 - \rightarrow The day will come when, \sim as Revelation tells us, \sim The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of his Christ, \sim and he shall reign forever and ever.

JESUS IS VERY ACTIVE ~ IN CREATION, ~ in the lives of his people, ~ and in human history.

CONCLUSION.
