► This ~ will give everything we talked about ~ 77

>>>regarding Paul's apostolic ministry to the church ~ a chance ~ to sink in.

►►And to keep the big picture in mind, ~ let's continue, ~ 77

Docommit ~ or ~ recommit ~ ourselves ~ to reading Colossians ~ at least once a week.

BACK IN JUNE, ~ WE DIPPED INTO 1 JOHN.

► We looked at 1:5.

 $\triangleright \triangleright$ John's assertion ~ that, ~ as the very literal translation says, ~ 77

God is light, ~ and darkness in Him ~ not is, ~ not one bit.

►►And today and next Sunday, ~ 77

>> we're going to go back to John's first epistle, ~ and look at 1 Jn. 2:15-17.

IN THIS BRIEF PARAGRAPH, ~ JOHN ~ 77

>> sounds a warning ~ to believers ~ about the world. 11/14

THE WAY JOHN HAS SET UP THIS PASSAGE ~ MAKES IT QUITE EASY ~ FOR US TO outline.

We'll do an overview ~ and then ~ begin to dig in to this passage.

▶▶1st, ~ John states ~ an exhortation, ~ verse 15a.

 $\triangleright \triangleright$ Do not love ~ the world ~ or ~ the things ~ in the world.

►►And then ~ he undergirds his exhortation with ~ 77

>>3 reasons ~ believers should not love the world or the things in the world, ~ Vv. 15b-17.

 $\triangleright \triangleright 1^{st}$, ~ Vs. 15b, ~ If anyone loves the world, ~ the love of the Father ~ is not ~ in him.

 $D > 2^{nd}$, ~ Verse 16, ~ For all that is in the world ~~ the desires of the flesh ~~ and the desires of the eyes ~~ and pride of life ~~ is not ~ from the Father ~ but ~ is from the world.

 $\triangleright \triangleright$ And 3rd, ~ Verse 17, ~ the world ~ is passing away ~ along with its desires, ~~ but ~ whoever does ~ the will of God ~ abides forever.

► Today, ~ we'll just cover Johns exhortation ~ and ~ his first reason ~ not to love the world.

THE BIBLE ~ OFTEN GIVES THE CHOICE ~ BETWEEN ~ loving the world ~ and ~ loving God.

▶▶Joshua ~ challenged the Israelites ~ to choose between ~ pagan gods ~ and the true God.

 $\triangleright \triangleright$ Joshua 24:15. ~~ And ~ if it is evil ~ in your eyes ~ to serve the Lord, ~~ choose this day ~ whom ~ you will serve, ~~ whether ~ the gods ~ your fathers served ~ in the region beyond the River, ~~ or ~ the gods of the Amorites ~ in whose land you dwell. ~~ But ~ as for me and my house, ~ we ~ will serve the Lord. 112/14

► Jesus gave his disciples a stark choice.

 $\triangleright \triangleright$ He told them ~ it is impossible ~ to serve ~ both God and Money.

 $\triangleright \triangleright$ Matthew 6:24.

 \rightarrow \rightarrow No one ~ can serve two masters, ~~ for either ~ he will hate the one ~ and love the other, ~ 77

 \rightarrow \rightarrow or ~ he will ~ be devoted to the one ~ and despise the other. ~~ 77

→ →You cannot ~ serve ~ God and money.

►► And here ~ in 1 Jn. 2:15-17, ~ John ~ takes up this topic.

<u>OK, ~ LET'S LOOK AT JOHN'S EXHORTATION.</u>

VERSE 15a, ~~ DO NOT LOVE ~ THE WORLD ~ OR ~ THE THINGS ~ IN THE WORLD.

▶▶Notice, ~ the exhortation is given ~ a double statement.

 $\triangleright \triangleright$ The first part ~ is comprehensive, ~ Do not love ~ the world.

 $\triangleright \triangleright$ The second part ~ is more specific, ~ or ~ the things ~ in the world.

 $\triangleright \triangleright$ The whole ~ and the parts.

 \rightarrow \rightarrow No exceptions ~ to the rule.

 \rightarrow Coming back to this ~ later the message. 11 3/14

▶▶"world" here ~ denotes ~ the evil earthly system, ~ totally under the grip of Satan, ~ 77

 \rightarrow and that displays ~ spiritual ignorance ~ 77

→ → and a pro sin and self, ~ anti-God, ~ materialistic ~ mentality.

►► To abbreviate this, ~ 77

 $\triangleright \triangleright$ in Colossians, ~ Paul ~ calls it, ~ and this should sound ~ very familiar, ~ the domain of darkness.

 $\triangleright \triangleright$ From which ~ believers have been ~ permanently rescued ~ 77

→ → and permanently transferred ~ to the kingdom of Jesus.

 $\triangleright \triangleright$ But, ~ due to the presence of our sin nature ~ still within in us ~ in this life, ~ 77

→ →it is still possible, ~ although ~ we can no longer be ~ a permanent part of it, ~ 77

 \rightarrow it is still possible ~ for us ~ to be enticed back ~ 77

→ → to ~ loving or participating in ~ this dark domain.

 $\triangleright \triangleright$ And John implies this ~ by his exhortation.

→ Just because we ~ are new creations in Christ, ~ it does not ~ make us immune ~ 77

 \rightarrow \rightarrow to ~ loving ~ or wanting to participate in ~ the domain of darkness. 11 4/14

▶ We could paraphrase it this way: ~~ Do not love ~ the domain of darkness.

IN THIS CONTEXT, ~ 77

▶▶love for the domain of darkness ~ is the same type of love ~ given to God.

▶ John says in the whole of verse 15, ~ 77

DDO not love the world ~ or the things in the world. ~~ 77

→ →^{15b} If anyone loves the world, ~ the love of the Father ~ is not in him.

► He's talking about ~ the same kind of love ~ in each instance.

AND LOVE HERE, ~ IF I UNDERSTAND IT CORRECTLY, ~ MEANS ~ ALLEGIANCE.

▶ That is ~ who we give ~ our allegiance to.

▶▶Just as Israel in the Old Testament ~ repeatedly had to decide ~ 77

DDbetween allegiance to God ~ & ~ allegiance to the pagan nations around them, ~ 77

→ →John is calling believers ~ to reject ~ allegiance to the domain of darkness.

▶▶So, ~ we can build ~ on our paraphrase ~ of John's exhortation.

 $\triangleright \triangleright$ Do not give ~ your allegiance ~ to ~ the domain of darkness. 11 5/14

►► And we can again ~ build on our paraphrase.

▶ The first part is comprehensive, ~ 77

DD not give ~ your allegiance ~ to the domain of darkness.

►►And now, ~ in the second part, ~ John gets more specific, ~ 77

DD or ~ to the things ~ that belong ~ to the domain of darkness.

THE WORDS, ~ "THE THINGS IN THE DOMAIN OF DARKNESS," ~ SPECIFY ~ THAT THIS exhortation ~ 77

covers ~ any ~ and all ~ particular aspects ~ of this domain.

► Anything ~ that is ~ rooted in ~ and characterized by ~ this domain is included.

▶▶Nothing ~ attached to the domain of darkness ~ is excluded.

►►E.g., ~ 77

Dbelievers ~ must ~ reject allegiance to ~ anti-God ~ philosophies, ~ values, ~ and principles.

 $\triangleright \triangleright$ We must ~ detach ourselves ~ from an idolatrous attitude ~ toward material things.

 \triangleright We must ~ distance ourselves ~ from the attitude ~ that calls ~ evil good ~ and good evil. 11 6/14

++this domain's ~ grumbling, ~ bitterness, in gratitude, ~ and covetousness, ~~ 77

 \rightarrow its obsession ~ with cares and riches and pleasures, ~ 77

→ → and its ~ preoccupation ~ with receiving praise from people.

▶▶In brief, ~ allegiance to anything ~ 77

DD that is ~ pro sin and self, ~ anti-God, ~ and materialistic.

→→TPID, ~ anything ~ not glorifying and pleasing to God, ~ 77

→ → must ~ be excluded ~ from our lives.

JOHN'S EXHORTATION.

DO NOT GIVE ~ YOUR ALLEGIANCE ~ TO ~ THE DOMAIN OF DARKNESS, ~ 77

▶▶or ~ to the things ~ that belong ~ to ~ this dark domain.

AND THEN, ~ AS WE NOTED, ~~ IN VERSES 15b-17, ~ 77

JOHN SETS FORTH ~ THREE REASONS ~ FOR HIS EXHORTATION.

▶ Three reasons ~ to not give our allegiance ~ to the domain of darkness ~ 77

DD or ~ the things that belong to it. 11 7/14

▶▶Just as a reminder, ~~ today, ~ we are going to look ~ only ~ at the first reason.

 $\triangleright \triangleright$ And ~ we'll take up the other two ~ next week

THE FIRST REASON, ~ VERSE 15b.

IF ANYONE ~ LOVES ~ [KEEP IN MIND ~ ALLEGIANCE] ~ THE WORLD ~ [i.e., ~ the domain of darkness], ~ 77

▶▶ the love of the Father is not in him.

▶▶"of" here ~ can be ~ and is best ~ looked at ~ as "for."

► The NIV ~ brings out the meaning quite well here.

 $\triangleright \triangleright$ If anyone ~ loves the world, ~ love ~ for ~ the Father ~ is not ~ in them.

▶▶Straightforward, ~ crystal clear, ~ blunt, ~ to the point, ~ and ~ the absolute truth.

 $\triangleright \triangleright$ We should ~ really let that ~ sink in.

▶ The first reason ~ for us ~ to not give ~ our allegiance ~ 77

>>> to the domain of darkness ~ is that ~ allegiance to this domain ~ 77

→→is completely ~ incompatible ~ with allegiance ~ to God.

>>You cannot ~ pledge allegiance ~ to the domain of darkness ~ or to anything ~ that belongs to it ~ 77

DD and ~ pledge allegiance to God ~ at the same time. 11 8/14

▶▶Notice, ~ with John ~ there is ~ no ~ gray area, ~ no ~ twilight zone.

▶▶IOW, ~ you can't have ~ a little bit of allegiance ~ 77

DD to both ~ the domain of darkness or anything that belongs to it ~ 77

→ →and to God.

THE DOMAIN OF DARKNESS ~ AND GOD ~~ ARE AT SUCH ODDS, ~~ 77

>> are so ~ violently and diametrically ~ opposed to one another, ~~ 77

 $\triangleright \triangleright$ are at such cross-purposes, ~ and are at total war with each other ~ 77

 \rightarrow \rightarrow that it is ~ simply impossible ~ to pledge allegiance to them both ~ at the same time.

►James points this out. ⇒⇒ James 4:4b (CSB).

 \triangleright Don't you know ~ that friendship with the world ~ is hostility toward God? ~~ So ~ whoever wants to be the friend of the world ~~ becomes ~ the enemy of God.

 \rightarrow No ~ middle ground.

► We've already read what Jesus said, ~ 77

DDNo one ~ can serve two masters, ~~ for either ~ he will hate the one ~ and love the other, ~~ or ~ he will be devoted ~ to the one ~ and despise ~ the other. ~~ You cannot ~ serve God and money.

 \rightarrow Again, ~ no ~ middle ground. 11 9/14

►►Also, ~ recall Joshua's challenge to the Israelites.

>>And if it is evil in your eyes ~ to serve the Lord, ~~ choose this day ~ whom you will serve, ~~ whether the gods your fathers served ~ in the region beyond the River, ~ or ~ the gods of the Amorites ~ in whose land you dwell.

 $\triangleright \triangleright$ Notice, ~ Joshua ~ gave them ~ only ~ two choices.

>> There was no ~ third choice, ~ which said ~ "or ~ both the false gods and Yahweh."

TO TRULY ~ SWEAR ALLEGIANCE TO GOD ~ MEANS ~ TO LOVES WHAT HE LOVES, ~ 7

to treasure what he treasures, ~ to take his part ~ and ~ to have ~ his interests ~ in your heart.

 $\triangleright \triangleright$ To truly ~ swear allegiance to God ~ is to set oneself against ~ 77

→ → everything ~ the domain of darkness ~ stands for, ~ values, ~ and seeks.

 $\triangleright \triangleright$ To choose God ~ is ~ to reject this dark domain.

▶ But, ~ if one ~ swears allegiance ~ 77

 $\triangleright \triangleright$ to even one thing ~ that's part ~ of the domain of darkness,

 \rightarrow \rightarrow then they are, ~ by that very fact, ~ 77

→→choosing ~ against God, ~ against ~ his will, ~ and ~ against ~ his interests.

 $\triangleright \triangleright$ And, ~ by extension, ~ we are choosing against ~ our own ~ spiritual wellbeing.

 $\triangleright \triangleright A$ believer ~ cannot ~ have it both ways. 11 10/14

JOHN'S EXHORTATION.

DO NOT GIVE ~ YOUR ALLEGIANCE ~ TO ~ THE DOMAIN OF DARKNESS, ~ 77

▶▶or ~ to the things ~ that belong ~ to ~ this dark domain.

Now, ~ is John just into ~ us keeping a bunch of rules?

 $\triangleright \triangleright Absolutely not.$

 $\triangleright \triangleright$ This exhortation ~ is for our spiritual well-being.

I'VE SAID THIS BEFORE, ~ IN OUR STUDY OF PHILIPPIANS, ~ 77

>> and I'll say it again ~ because it's so very, ~ very ~ important ~ to understand.

 \blacktriangleright God ~ doesn't give us ~ a bunch of commands ~ 77

DD simply because he wants us to obey ~ a bunch of commands.

 $\triangleright \triangleright$ He's not some ~ cosmic killjoy ~ who wants ~ 77

→ → to restrict our freedom ~ or ~ to prevent us ~ from having fun.

 \rightarrow This is what Satan, ~ the world, ~ and our sin nature ~ would have us believe.

 $\triangleright \triangleright \mathsf{Far}$ from it.

>>Every one ~ of God's commands ~ are ~ for our spiritual well-being. 11/14

→→Every one ~ of God's commands in Scripture ~ are: ~ 77

→ for our good, ~~ help us grow spiritually, ~ 77

→ → and help us become more and more like Jesus.

 \blacktriangleright And ~ when we obey his commands, ~ 77

>>> far from feeling restricted ~ or miserable, ~ 77

→ we will find ~ incredible freedom and joy.

 $\triangleright \triangleright I$ once again ~ call your attention ~ to the chorus of the old hymn.

→→ "Trust and obey, ~ for there's no other way ~ to be happy in Jesus, ~ 77

→→but ~ to trust and obey."

→→This is not some religious hogwash, ~ trite saying, ~ legalistic nonsense, ~ 77

→ →or an appeal to guilt-trip Christianity.

 \rightarrow This is a theologically rich, ~ biblically sound, ~ and true statement.

▶▶I would strongly suggest to you ~ that genuine believer ~ is never more miserable ~ 77

DD than when we are <u>not</u> following ~ our Lord's commands.

 $\triangleright \triangleright$ Sin ~ brings only a very brief period of happiness. 11 12/14

 $\triangleright \triangleright$ But ultimately ~ sin brings ~ misery and inner turmoil ~ into our lives.

→→David recalled the time after he sinned against Bathsheba and Uriah, ~ 77

→ → when he kept silent ~ and refused to confess his sin to God.

→ → Ps. 32:3-4 (CSB).

→ When I kept silent, ~~ my bones ~ became brittle ~ from my groaning all day
long. ~~ For day and night ~ your hand was heavy on me; ~~ my strength was drained
~ as in the summer's heat.

▶▶On the other hand, ~ joy and peace ~ are by-products of walking by the Spirit.

>>I.e., ~ when a genuine believer lives according to God's word, ~ they will experience ~ joy and inner peace.

⊳⊳**Ps**. 1:1-2.

→→Blessed ~ [i.e., ~ O, ~ how happy] ~ is the man ~ who walks not ~ in the counsel of the wicked, ~~ nor stands ~ in the way of sinners, ~~ nor sits ~ in the seat of scoffers; ~~ but his delight ~ is ~ in the law of the Lord, ~~ and on his law ~ he meditates ~ day and night.

 $\triangleright \triangleright \mathsf{Ps.}$ 119, ~ verses 1-2, ~ NIV.

→→Blessed ~ [or, ~ Joyful] ~ are those ~ whose ways are blameless, ~ who walk according to the law of the Lord. ~~ 77

 \rightarrow \rightarrow Blessed ~ [or, ~ Joyful] ~ are those ~ who keep his statutes ~~ and seek him ~ with all their heart.

→→And Ps. 119, ~ verse 165a, ~~ Great peace have those ~ who love your law. 11 13/14

BELIEVERS, ~ FOR YOUR SPIRITUAL WELL-BEING, ~ JOHN SAYS, ~ 77

>> Do not give ~ your allegiance ~ to ~ the domain of darkness, ~ 77
